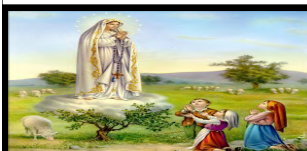
Beginning Monday, June 17, the office will be on summer hours. We will be open on Monday 9 am—2 pm, and Friday 9 am—12 Noon.
