ARE YOU CONSIDERING BECOMING CATHOLIC?
RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, is the process in which the Catholic Church welcomes people into the Church. RCIA is a process in which conversion of heart brings one to Jesus through learning, discussion, prayer and community.

You might want to join RCIA if you are in one of the 3 categories listed below:

*** Those adults who are not baptized and are considering entrance in the Catholic Church through Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

*** Adults who were baptized in another tradition and are considering becoming a Catholic.

*** Adults who were baptized Catholic but did not complete their initiation through Confirmation, and/or First Eucharist.

We will have two discernment (Come and See) sessions. One will be at St. Rita on August 18 following the 11 am Mass and one at St. Luke on August 25 after 10 am Mass. At both sessions, we will explain the process, answer questions and take registrations.

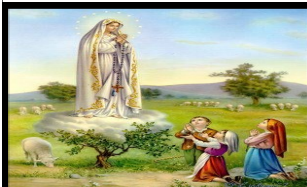

ARCHDIOCESE OF LOUISVILLE FAMILY MINISTRIES—SUPPORT MEETING FOR PARENTS OF FOSTER, DOMESTIC, AND INTERNATIONALLY ADOPTED CHILDREN: The Archdiocese of Louisville is beginning a Support Group for Foster Care, Domestic and International adoptive parents. We have scheduled our first meeting for this parents on Tuesday, August 13, at St. Michael (Community Room) located at 3703 Stone Lakes Drive, from 6:30-8:00 PM) One of the common threads for children in foster care and internationally adopted children is the experience of significant trauma, and the resulting emotional problems that can result. The Support Group meeting is designed around a proven model that has been in place in many Churches originated by ORPHAN CARE ALLIANCE. OCA Connect meetings provide an opportunity for foster and adoptive parents to journey together by meeting monthly for support and encouragement led by a trained professional specializing in trauma. Each meeting is led by a professional that guides the discussion to create a safe community for sharing stories and offering encouragement. OCA Connect conversations don't leave the room and parents will know that aren't alone in their challenges. The meetings will empower families to respond to their child's behavior in a manner that acknowledges past trauma but promotes the learning of new, more adaptive reactions to stress.

The meetings will be 90 minutes consisting of:

- * Prayer and parenting tips from a Catholic perspective.
- * Adoption/trauma care specialist presentation
- * Q & A and discussion
