**Healthy at Worship – Archdiocese of Louisville  
Public Masses and other Liturgical Celebrations During the  
COVID-19 Pandemic**

Archbishop Kurtz is issuing a **dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation for the Archdiocese of Louisville, until further notice.** Anyone who is sick or living with someone who is sick **should stay home**, as should anyone who feels vulnerable for other reasons. Online masses are available at [www.archlou.org/COVID-19](http://www.archlou.org/COVID-19)

Further guidance will be provided about the process for infant baptisms, bringing the Elect and candidates for full Communion into the Church, and the resumption of First Communions and Confirmations.

We will arrange seating to allow at least six feet between parishioners, with an exception made for members of the same household: Red dots will be placed on every other pew that are not open for seating. Available seating will be to allow for social distancing. **Seating will be first come, first served.**

Hand sanitizer will be provided at the entrances.

During this initial period of re-opening, **all parishioners should wear face coverings or masks when attending Mass.**

Church will be cleaned after every mass.

If you have any health issues you are asked to please stay at home.

Please wash your hands before coming to mass and, if possible, please take your temperature.

Bathroom use is limited to one person at a time during Masses.

We will be distributing Holy Communion after Mass with the Priest and Extraordinary Ministers moving through the pews to distribute Communion as opposed to having people form lines.

Please place offerings in baskets at entrances to the Church.

Other non-liturgical gatherings on church property continue to be postponed.

Please remain quiet in the church before Mass so that we can pray and prepare ourselves for the Mass.

This weekend, there will be a collection for Catholic World Missions. This collection funds pastoral and evangelizing programs for the poorest faith communities, here and abroad, through the Society for the Propagation of the Faith and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association. Contributions help establish new parishes and missions, train and support lay catechists, and provide many other ministries and programs. Due to COVID-19, our annual church picnic has been cancelled. We will be planning some fund raisers for later in the year, if possible. If you have any ideas, please let us know.

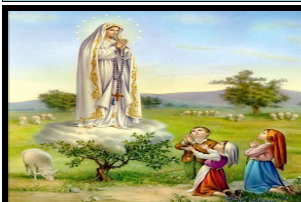
### CRUSADE FOR CHILDREN
