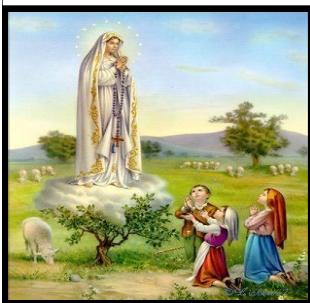
**Please remain quiet in the church before Mass so that we can pray and prepare ourselves for the Mass.**
