SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS NEEDED FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS: Do you like to work with children and youth? Are you seeking a part-time job that will enrich your life? The Archdiocese of Louisville is seeking substitute teachers for its preschool through grade 12 elementary and secondary schools, located in seven counties of the Archdiocese (Hardin, Jefferson, Marion, Nelson, Oldham, Shelby, and Washington counties). While it is not necessary for substitutes to have a teaching certificate, candidates should have at least 60 hours of college credit and must submit a resume, college transcript, and two letters of reference. 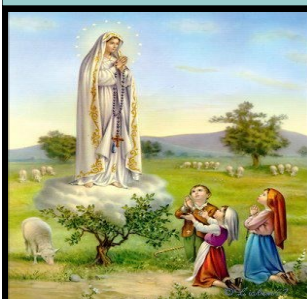
***Quilting Group is hand quilting a beautiful quilt. Please come and join us. Friday Afternoons at 12:00. All are welcome!
