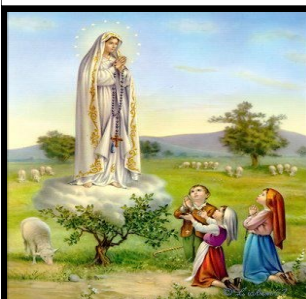
KNIGHTS ANNUAL TOOTSIE ROLL DRIVE:
