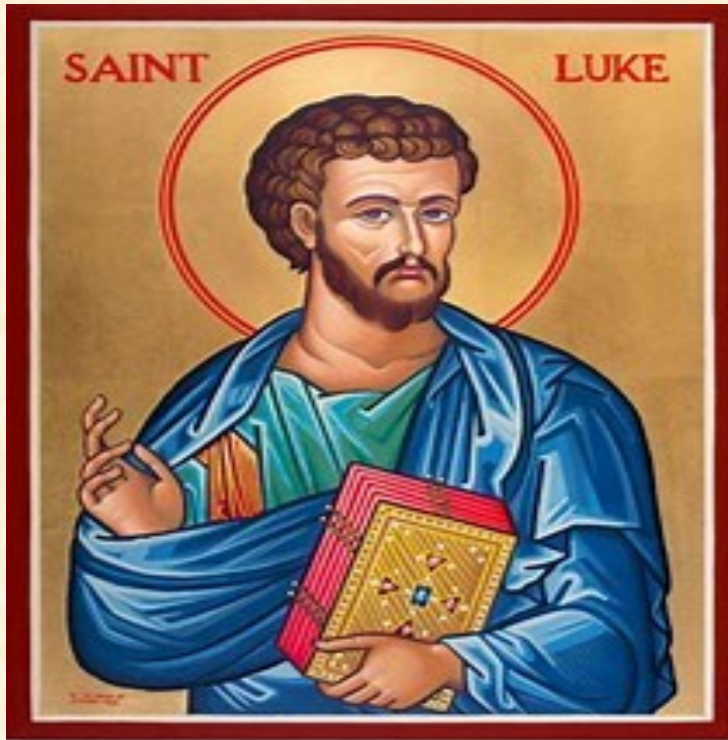

The weekend of October 24-25, 2020, the Knights of Columbus will be holding their annual Tootsie Roll Drive after all the masses.

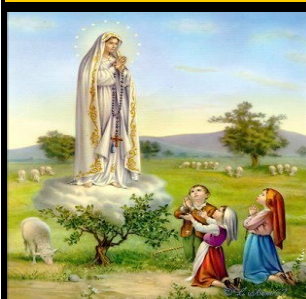
