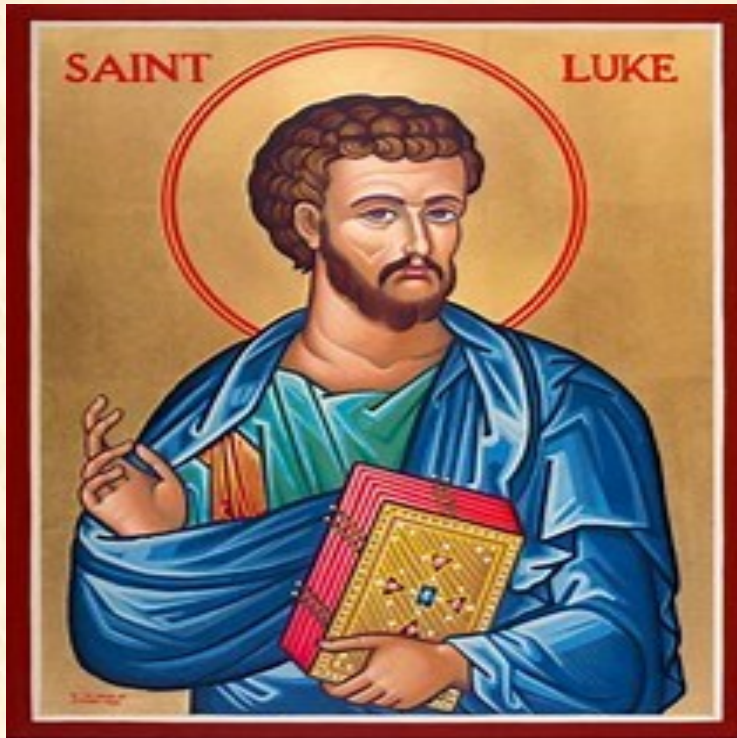

## ARCHDIOCESAN ANNIVERSARY MASS 2020

Due to COVID-19 procedures, this year's Anniversary Mass with Archbishop Kurtz will be shown online.

The Mass will be filmed on October 8, 2020 and made available via the Archdiocese YouTube Channel and website shortly thereafter.

The DIACONATE ORDINATION of Quan Nguyen and Loi Pham will be celebrated by Archbishop Joseph Kurtz on Saturday, November 28, 2020 at 10am. The people of the Archdiocese of Louisville are welcome and encouraged to view the livestream of this joyful celebration. During these very challenging times of NTI (Non-Traditional Instruction) in our schools, the Office of Multicultural Ministry's Catholic Enrichment Center is offering virtual and in-person homework assistance and basic academic review for students in grades K-12 to assist in their learning. Tutoring will be provided by experienced educators. The cost is \$50 per month for one-hour sessions. The sessions are offered on Mondays and Tuesdays, virtual from 3-4 PM and in person from 5-7 PM. They are by appointment only and must be scheduled in advance. You must call to register your child. These hours are until December 15. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and CDC guidelines, the number of students allowed for the in-person tutoring will be limited. Contact the CEC at 776-0262 for more details or to schedule your child. ## Conversations with Archbishop Kurtz

During segment one of November's *Conversations with Archbishop Kurtz*, Chancellor Dr. Brian Reynolds and Archbishop Kurtz discuss the annual observance of African American Catholic History Month and three African American Catholic heroes: Father Augustus Tolton, Sister Thea Bowman, and Kentucky native Daniel Rudd. In segment two, Archbishop welcomes guests Eva Gonzalez to talk about her work as the first diocesan director for the new Office of Hispanic Ministry. In segment three, Archbishop Kurtz talks with Dr. Karen Shadle, director of the Office of Worship, about why Catholics worship communally and the meaning of the Sunday Mass obligation.

*Conversations* airs on the Faith Channel (Spectrum channels 19 and digital channel 279) on Tues. at 7 p.m., Wed. at 10 a.m., Fri. at 7 p.m., and Sat. at 4 p.m. It is on radio stations WLCR 1040 AM, Breadbox Media, and WLHN 95.3 FM in Meade County. In addition, *Conversations* can be downloaded for no charge through iTunes. *Conversations* also is available on Bardstown Cable Channel 19 (BRTV) at 7 p.m. on the first two Monday nights of the month and on Bardstown's PLG TV on Tuesday afternoons at 4 p.m. and Saturdays and Sundays at 11:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. *Conversations* is online at [www.archlou.org/conversations](http://www.archlou.org/conversations).

This weekend the Knights of Columbus will be holding their annual Tootsie Roll Drive after all the masses.

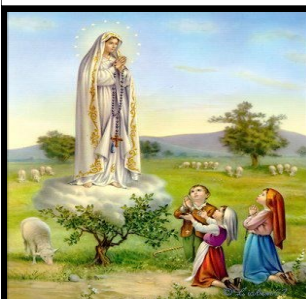
