CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT TEST

Students who wish to attend a Catholic high school next year are required to take the Catholic high school placement test scheduled on Saturday, December 12, from 9 AM to 12:30 PM. The placement test is free of charge and helps Catholic secondary schools determine the most appropriate course work and academic path for meeting the needs of each student.

Students take the test at the Catholic high school they plan to attend. This year, due to COVID-19, students are asked to preregister on that high school's website. Links to preregister for the high school placement test can be found at www.louisvillecatholicschools.com/placementtest.

Students should bring two #2 pencils and a face mask as each school will adhere to safe and healthy testing guidelines.

During segment one of November's *Conversations with Archbishop Kurtz*, Chancellor Dr. Brian Reynolds and Archbishop Kurtz discuss the annual observance of African American Catholic History Month and three African American Catholic heroes: Father Augustus Tolton, Sister Thea Bowman, and Kentucky native Daniel Rudd. In segment two, Archbishop welcomes guests Tim Tomes, Archivist, to talk about his work as the first full-time Archivist for the Archdiocese of Louisville. In segment three, Archbishop Kurtz talks with Dr. Karen Shadle, director of the Office of Worship, about why Catholics worship communally and the meaning of the Sunday Mass obligation. *Conversations* airs on the Faith Channel (Spectrum channels 19 and digital channel 279) on Tues. at 7 p.m., Wed. at 10 a.m., Fri. at 7 p.m., and Sat. at 4 p.m. It is on radio stations WLCR 1040 AM, Breadbox Media, and WLHN 95.3 FM in Meade County. 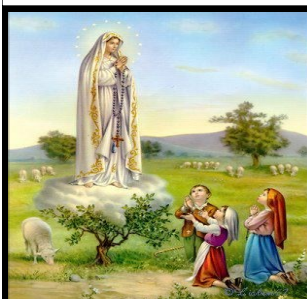
